Statement of CSO of all its completed contracts similar to the Community-based projects to be bid and/or list indicating the work experiences of their members that reflect the capacity to deliver the Goods at an equal of higher established standards. waive any defect and to accept such offers as may be considered advantageous to PCA.7. The PE shall require performance and warranty securities to the winning organized CSG/CSO in
accordance with Sections 9 & 62 of R.A. 9184 and its 2016 Revised IRR.

Payment shall be released based on the terms provided in the contract and only upon validation by the End-User unit that the CSG/CSO has delivered or performed the outputs specified in the contract and the same has been inspected and accepted by the PE as satisfactory in accordance with the technical specifications or scope of work, and applicable government budgeting, accounting, and auditing rules.
