- 4. Quotations exceeding the Approved Budget for the Contract shall be rejected.
- Award of contract shall be made to the lowest quotation which complies with the technical specifications, schedule of requirements and terms and conditions stated herein.
- 6. Any interlineations, erasures or overwriting shall be valid only if they are signed or initiated by you or your duly authorized representative.
- 7. The PCA Regions I-III RBAC shall have the right to inspect the goods to confirm their conformity to the technical specifications once delivered.
- 8. All items should be delivered in thirty (60) calendar days after signing of Contract.
- 9. Liquidated damages equivalent to one tenth of one percent (0.001%) of the value of the goods not delivered within the prescribed delivery period shall be imposed per day of delay.
