The penalty for the late deliveries is one tenth (1/10) of one (1) percent of the cost of the unperformed portion for every day of delay. The maximum deduction shall be ten percent (10%) of the contract price. Once the cumulative amount of the liquidated damage reaches ten percent (10%) of the contract price, the procuring entity shall rescind the contract without prejudice to other courses of action and remedies open to it.

The PCA reserves the right to reject any and all bids, declare a failure of bidding, or not award the contract in accordance with Section 41 or RA 9184 and its IRR, without thereby incurring any liability to the affected bidder or bidders.

TERMS OF REFERENCE

Supply and Delivery Medical Supplies for the Conduct of the CFIDP-On-The-Go Farmer's Assembly and Medical and Dental Health Missions

 Medical Supplies to be Procured for the Conduct of the Medical and Dental Health Mission: The Philippine Coconut Authority (PCA) Region IX, will procure various medical supplies for the conduct of a medical and dental health mission in Region IX as part of PCA's implementation of its Health and Medical Program for Coconut Farmers and Their Families under Republic Act No. 11524, otherwise known as the Coconut Farmers and Industry Trust Fund (CFITF) Act of 2021 and the Coconut Farmers and Industry Development Plan (CFIDP) approved through Executive Order No. 172 Series of 2022.

The amount of **Ninety Six Thousand Seven Hundred Twelve Pesos (Php 96,712.00)** was the Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC). The detailed list and quantity of the medical supplies are specified in **Annex A**.

- 2. **Viability of Medical Supplies**: Expiring medical supplies to be delivered must have expiry dates as follows:
 - a. At least one (1) year from the date of delivery of medical supplies with a shelf life of three (3) years or less;
 - b. At least two (2) years from the date of delivery for medical supplies with a shelf life of more than three (3) years.

3. Pull-out and Replacement of Near-Expiring Medical Supplies:

- a. <u>Pull-out</u>: The awardee/supplier shall pull-out near expiring unused stocks at least three (3) months prior to the date of expiration of expiring medical supplies.
- b. <u>Replacement</u>: The awardee/supplier shall replace the pulled-out stocks with fresh stocks, i.e. replacement stocks shall have an expiration date of at least one (1) year from date of its delivery. Replacement stocks shall be delivered within seven (7) days reckoned from the date of the pull-out of near-expiring medical supplies.
- 4. **Delivery Period:** The awardee/supplier shall deliver the medical supplies within seven (7) calendar days from receipt of Notice to Proceed (NTP) or Notice to Deliver (NTD) to be issued by PCA Region IX.



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The medical supplies shall be delivered to PCA Region IX or to any of its provincial offices if so required by PCA Region IX ensuring for the purpose that actual delivery shall take place not less than seven (7) days before the scheduled medical and dental health mission which will be conducted by PCA Region IX.

5. Schedule of Medical and Dental Health Mission: As mentioned the awardee/supplier shall deliver the medical supplies to PCA Region IX or to any of its provincial offices if so required by PCA Region IX not less than seven (7) days before the scheduled medical and dental health mission after said awardee/supplier receives a Notice to Proceed (NTP) or Notice to Deliver (NTD) to be issued by the PCA Region IX.

For reference purposes, attached as **Annex B**, the schedule of medical and dental health mission which will be conducted by PCA R Region IX. The said schedule is subject to change by both PCA Central Office and PCA Region IX and may extend after year 2023. Also indicated are the details of contact persons and addresses of PCA Region IX and its provincial offices where the medicines shall be delivered by the awardee/supplier.

- 6. **Medical Supplies to be Delivered for the Medical and Dental Health Mission**: There are three (3) sets of medical supplies which the awardee/supplier shall deliver for each medical and dental health mission. These are:
 - a. <u>Medical Supplies for the Dental Group</u>: The medical supply shall be properly packaged and marked "*Medical Supplies for the Dental Group*" separate from the other set of medical supplies ensuring that the medical items and container used to package these items will not be prone to damage in cases when there is a need to transport them by the end-user under heavy rain.
 - b. <u>Medical Supplies for the Medical Group</u>: The medical supply shall be properly packaged and marked *"Medical Supplies for the Medical Group"* separate from the other set of medical supplies ensuring that the medical items and container used to package these items will not be prone to damage in cases when there is a need to transport them by the end-user under heavy rain.
 - c. <u>Health Kit for Coconut Farmers</u>: All medical and health items specified to be part of the Health Kit shall be packaged in a resealable bag or kit for efficient distribution. Similarly, the resealable bag or kit containing the medical and health items shall be properly packaged and marked *"Health Kit for Coconut Farmers"* separate from the other set of medical supplies ensuring that the medical items and container used to package these items will not be prone to damage in cases when there is a need to transport them by the end-user under heavy rain.

The proposed designed of and specific medical and health items included inside the Health Kit for Coconut Farmers are attached as **Annex C**.

7. **Payment Terms:** The delivered medical supplies shall be immediately inspected on the same day it was delivered by the PCA Regional Inspectorate Group, together with a representative from the Commission on Audit (COA) and other concerned parties as may be deemed necessary to check compliance with the TOR prior to



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Payments shall be computed based on the actual quantity of medicines inspected and accepted by PCA Region IX. Each payment shall be processed upon receipt of the sales invoice and other supporting documents necessary to facilitate the processing of payment.

8. Liquidated Damages: In case of delayed delivery of supplies and service(s), the PCA may upon its discretion, extend the delivery period, subject, however, to the imposition of appropriate liquidated damages, the amount of which shall be at least equal to one-tenth of one percent (0.001) of the cost of the unperformed portion for very day of delay, collectible from any money due or maybe due to the supplier/contractor, whichever is convenient to PCA. Once the cumulative amount of liquidated damages reached ten percent (10%) of the amount of the contract, the PCA may rescind or terminate the contract, without prejudice to other courses of action and remedies open to it. If the supplier, however fail to effect complete delivery within the extended period, the PCA shall have the right to cancel said contract, and shall constitute a ground for the supplier to be disqualified from future biddings, without prejudice to the imposition of other sanctions provided for under Republic Act No. 9184 and its 2016 Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR).
