Coconut-Based Organizations (CBOs)

- Farmer participants must be registered in the National Coconut Farmers Registry System (NCFRS)
- Must be a registered coconut farmers' organization or cooperative
- With at least 50 active members
- Priority are farmers with 0.5-1.0 hectare of farmland

About PCA
