

RE: VALIDATION RESULT OF PCA'S 2018 PERFORMANCE SCORECARD

Dear Sec. Piñol and OIC-Admin. Santos,



In line with Item 2 of **GCG M.C. No. 2017-01**² particularly the achievement of a weighted-average score of at least 90% in its 2018 Performance Scorecard, PCA is ineligible to grant the Performance Based Bonus (PBB) to its officers and employees. In this regard, the Board is reminded that any unilateral action to release the PBB will be considered as a violation of the Board's fiduciary duty to protect the assets of the GOCC as provided under Section 19 of Republic Act No. 10149.³

Consequently, pursuant to GCG M.C. No. 2016-01,⁴ failure to qualify for the PBB means that the Appointive Members of the Governing Board of PCA shall not be qualified to receive the Performance-Based Incentive (PBI).
